Burglary arrest

On Tuesday, November 11, 2008, at 7:06 p.m. Officers of the Redding Police Department responded to an address in the 1700 block of Wisconsin Avenue regarding a burglary that just occurred. The resident was home at the time and reported seeing a shadow of a subject inside of her house. The victim called out to the subject, but did not recognize the voice of the female subject who replied.

Upon arrival, officers searched the backyard of the residence and the surrounding area, but were unable to locate the suspect. During a search of the neighborhood, Officers observed a vehicle parked several blocks away, belonging to a Tracy Merrill Mumford, 45 years, of Redding. Mumford had been associated with several recent residential burglaries.

Officers contacted Mumford in her vehicle. After a brief conversation, Mumford admitted that she was responsible for the burglary. Mumford was arrested and booked into the Shasta County Jail. She is currently being held in lieu of bail in the amount of \$10,000.
