PC 187 Homicide Investigation Update  
08-51003

On August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008, at approximately 7:12 AM, the Redding Police Department responded to 2001 Hartnell Avenue on the report of shots fired inside apartment number 35.

Patricia Haggard, age 56, and a resident of apartment 35, was taken to UC Davis Medical Center for treatment of her burn injuries and is in serious condition but improving.

Phillip Lampella, age 28, was found with a gunshot wound to the shoulder. He was taken to Mercy Hospital and is in stable condition. Shasta Maw, age 27, was found with a gunshot wound to the lower torso. She was also taken to Mercy Hospital and is in stable condition. Both are now out of Intensive Care.

Interviews with Lampella and Maw have been completed. Based on the information they provided, Investigators believe Kenneth Alfred, age 63, entered the residence through a door in the garage. Alfred was confronted by Lampella downstairs. Alfred threatened Lampella with a handgun. Lampella retreated to a bedroom upstairs and tried to fight off Alfred. Alfred then shot Lampella once in the shoulder. Alfred then shot at Maw twice, striking her one time. Lampella was able to force the door closed to keep Alfred out. Alfred fired one more round through the door, missing both victims.

It is believed Alfred then confronted and shot Nancy Bosley, age 63, who was located in a second upstairs bedroom. Alfred then continued his rampage by dousing Patricia Haggard with gasoline he brought with him to the residence in a salad dressing bottle. Alfred set fire to Haggard. Eventually he committed suicide by shooting himself in the head. In the suicide note he left behind, Alfred stated his intentions to kill Maw and Bosley, and to make Haggard suffer.

The autopsies were performed yesterday on Kenneth Alfred and Nancy Bosley. The autopsy results will be available at a later date.
