Driving Under the Influence/ Driver License Checkpoint

January 30, 2008

The Redding Police Department conducted a DUI and driver license checkpoint between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. on Friday, January 30, 2008 on Churn Creek Road north of Maraglia Street.

A total of 770 vehicles passed through the checkpoint and were screened by officers. 657 drivers were stopped for further investigation, either at the checkpoint or by officers patrolling near the checkpoint. 4 drivers were given field sobriety tests with 2 being arrested for driving under the influence. 3 drivers were cited for traffic violations, including 2 drivers who were driving on a suspended license. 4 vehicles were towed, including those of the suspended drivers.
