Traffic Collision

On Thursday, October 1, 2009 at 1235PM officers from the Redding Police Department responded to an "unknown injury" traffic collision on SR 273 at Girvan Rd. When officers arrived on scene they found a tan Dodge passenger car blocking the westbound lanes of Girvan at SR 273 and a silver Honda and blue Bulck passenger car blocking the right-hand lane of northbound SR 273 and the eastbound lane of Girvan.

The driver of the Dodge, Belva Page, 67 years of Shasta Lake City, was stopped in the turn lane for eastbound Girvan on SR 273. She then attempted to make a left-hand (eastbound) turn onto Girvan against a red light. She collided with the Honda, which was traveling northbound on SR 273 in the right-hand lane at about 45 mph. The impact caused the Honda to collide with the Bulck, which was stopped on the east side of SR 273 on Girvan at a red light. All vehicles came to rest on their wheels.

Belva Page and her husband, Robert Page, 68 years of Shasta Lake City, who was a passenger in the vehicle, were transported to Mercy hospital. Belva Page received an abrasion on her right arm. Robert Page suffered a small cut and bruise on his left leg and a broken right leg. The driver of the Honda, Marianne Giddings, 49 years of Redding, received a cut and bruise on her left knee and complained of lower back and hip pain. She was transported to Mercy Hospital. Her passenger, Angela Giddings, 22 years of Redding, was transported to Mercy Hospital for a complaint of lower back pain.
