On October 1, 2009 at 4:25 pm, Officer Marks made a traffic stop on Montera Lane, just off Churn Creek Road for a speeding violation. While Officer Marks was in the process of identifying the driver, the driver suddenly fled on foot. Officer Marks pursued the suspect to the area of DeMoll Drive and Churn Creek Road, where he lost site of the subject as he climbed a fence. Responding officers set up a perimeter and CHP Helicopter also assisted in the search.

Officers located the suspect baracaded inside a residence in the 1000 block of Montera Lane. The suspect refused to comply with officers demands to submit to arrest and officers forced entry into the residence. The suspect was located hiding inside a refrigerator, which was in the garage.

The suspect was identified as being a 17 year old from Redding. He was booked in the Shasta County Juvenile Hall on charges of providing false information to Police Officer, Resisting arrest, Unlicensed driver and Probation violation. Suspects name is withheld, due to him being a juvenile.
