On Sunday, October 4, 2009 at 4:56 p.m. James Fulk, age 32, of Red Bluff, was seen by riding in the rear seat of a passenger car on Highway 273 at Canyon Rd. Officer Solada knew that Fulk was a wanted parolee with a long history of violent criminal activity and two felony warrants for his arrest. Officer Solada also was aware that Mr. Fulk often ran from law enforcement and asked for the help from canine officer Kinneavy. Officer Solada made a traffic stop on the vehicle on Eastside road.

As the car slowed down, Mr. FULK jumped from the vehicle. Redding police canine VERMUT was sent to apprehend D/FULK.

After running for 60 yards, D/FULK was apprehended by canine VERMUT and Officer KINNEAVY.

D/FULK was taken to the hospital to be treated for injuries he received during the arrest. D/FULK was booked into Shasta county jail for felony parole warrants and one misdemeanor charge of resisting arrest.
