Today, at 1:06 P.M., Redding Police Department officers were dispatched to the 11300 block of Rugby Hill Drive in regards to an interrupted residential burglary.

Victim, Janet Pike, 42 years old reported hearing a noise in her home and seeing a male subject leaving her yard area and get into a champagne colored smaller sedan. The suspect was described as a white male wearing sunglasses and dark colored gloves.

Patrol officers responded to the area along with the California Highway Patrol helicopter. The helicopter reported observing a vehicle matching the description near Collyer Drive and Churn Creek Road. Officer Duane Morrison located the suspect vehicle and detained the driver. The driver was identified as James W. Curle, 19 years old of Redding. Mr. Curle was identified by the victim as the responsible person. Stolen property from the victim's home was located in Curle's vehicle. Mr. Curle is currently on felony probation for an illegal drug possession conviction.

He was arrested and booked into the Shasta County Jail for burglary and probation violation.
