On 10/26/2009 at 5:10 PM the Redding Police Department received a call of an 11 year old runaway in the Enterprise area. The juvenile left his residence after a disagreement over school work. The parents searched the surrounding neighborhood for approximately a half hour before notifying the Redding Police Department.

Concerned over the safety of the juvenile due to his age, several officers responded to the area. Officers searched the neighborhood, local businesses, and other areas where the juvenile has frequented in the past. After not being able to locate the juvenile, the police department used a reverse 9-1-1 communicator to contact local citizens in the area to be on the look out for the juvenile. The local media was also notified.

Within 30 minutes the juvenile was located after management at Burger King on Cypress Avenue notified the police department. The child was in good health and was transported back to his residence where he was reunited with his parents.
