On 02/18/2009 at 6:53 PM, Officers from the Redding Police Department responded to the area of 730 Lake Blvd in response to an interrupted residential burglary. Victim Joshua Miles, 28 years of Redding, returned home to find a male subject exiting his residence with several of his personal belongings. The male suspect dropped the items and fled on foot.

Witnesses in the area observed a male who matched the description of the suspect running down a hill off Lake Blvd towards the railroad tracks.

A police K-9 team was called in and began a track of the suspect where the witnesses last saw him. After a long track through a heavily wooded area, Suspect Kurt LENARZ, 28 years of Redding, was located by the police dog. LENARZ was found hiding among some brush bordering a residential apartment complex in the 500 block of Buckeye Terrance and taken into custody without incident.

After being positively identified by the Victim, Kurt LENARZ was arrested and booked into Shasta County Jail on charges of residential burglary and violation of probation.
