Officers of the Redding Police Department were called to a report of vandalism to Cascade Park on Girvan Road. On arrival, Officer Ellis learned that a pickup truck had been driving in circles on the lawn area, intentionally damaging the park property. Officer Ellis searched the area and found a truck parked in front of 6474 Creekside Street that matched witness descriptions.

Officer Ellis met with the trucks owner, Benjamin Holmes, age 20, who lived at the Creekside Street address. Officers found that Holmes was on Home Electronic Confinement due to an earlier conviction. After a short conversation, Holmes admitted to driving his truck across the park lawns. Another person inside the Creekside address confirmed Holmes had vandalized the park.

Benjamin Holmes was arrested and booked into Shasta County Jail for violating the conditions of Home Electronic Confinement. A complaint will be filed with the Shasta County District Attorney seeking a charge of felony vandalism.
