On Saturday 2/28/09 at 1120 am, Anderson Police Dispatch received a phone call from a citizen who reported seeing a vehicle matching the description from a Hit and Run Collision in Redding.

The caller heard the description of the vehicle while listening to a local media broadcast on the radio.

Anderson Police Officers located the vehicle and driver at the intersection of Deschutes Road and Arby Street in Anderson.

Redding Police Officers responded to the location, to conduct further investigation. Officers located a green 1993 Jeep Grand Cherokee, having drivers side front end damage. The damage was recent, and matched the original collision damages. The vehicle was impounded.

The driver acknowledged having been in a collision, but had not yet reported the incident to police.

The driver was identified as Tamara Kerrie Clark, 29 years of age, from Fairfield, California. She was not injured as a result of the collision an arrest has not yet been made, as statements, evidence and other information is still being evaluated. The case will soon be submitted to the Shasta County District Attorney's Office for review.
