On Tuesday, February 10, 2009 at 6:10 P.M. officers from the Redding Police Department were dispatched to a report of a non-injury collision at Shasta St. at Market St.

As officers arrived, witnesses said that the responsible party was leaving the scene. The suspect vehicle was identified as a 1996 Toyota Tacoma California license 5H36402.

The Toyota was located turning southbound on Market St., and accelerated rapidly. It failed to negotiate a left turn onto Tehama St. and crashed into the corner of Scott Halsey's Kenpo Karate Studio, 1401 Market St. The driver was identified as Stanley Racine, 61 years, of Redding. He attempted to flee the scene in his vehicle; however, was unable to do so due to damage to his vehicle as a result of the collision.

The investigation revealed that Racine had been traveling South on Market St. and ran the red light at Shasta St. Racine's vehicle collided with two other vehicles, driven by Jesse Treas, and Timothy Dopp both of Redding.

Racine was transported to Shasta Regional Medical Center for medical clearance prior to being booked into the Shasta County Jail for being a felon in possession of a hand gun, driving under the influence of alcohol, hit and run, resisting arrest, and a parole violation.
