On February 11, 2009 at approximately 10:30 p.m., Officers of the Shasta Anti-Gang Enforcement Team (S.A.G.E.), California Department of Corrections Fugitive Apprehension Team, and the United States Marshal's Office arrested Andrew Glenn West, 45 years, at his residence in north Redding.

Officers initially responded to this location to conduct a parole check of West's residence. Upon arrival, West refused to open his door and allow officers entry. West was observed through a window dumping suspected controlled substances into the toilet.

After West refused repeated demands to open the door, officers forced entry and took West into custody. Officers located suspected methamphetamine, marijuana, a large amount of currency and paraphernalia consistent with illegal drug sales such as scales, pipes, notations and baggies.

West was booked into the Shasta County Jail for a parole violation, resisting and obstructing officers, destroying evidence, possessing methamphetamine and marijuana for sale, and maintaining a residence where illegal drugs are used and sold.
