On February 11, 2009 at approximately 6:30 p.m., Officers of the Shasta Anti-Gang Enforcement Team (S.A.G.E.), California Department of Corrections Fugitive Apprehension Team, and the United States Marshal's Office arrested Howard Augusta Scott D.O.B. 06/02/49 in the downtown area of Redding. Scott was wanted on an arrest warrant out of the state of Utah charging him with kidnapping and homicide.

Scott will ultimately be transported by the United States Marshal's Office back to Utah to face the charges listed on the warrant. Any questions regarding Scott's arrest shall be directed to the United States Marshal's Office in Sacramento at (916) 930-2030.

The Shasta Anti-Gang Enforcement team (S.A.G.E.) continues to operate on a weekly basis serving the needs of Shasta County. S.A.G.E. is a coalition of 19 Shasta County law enforcement organizations at the federal, state and local levels that work together to police known and suspected gang members.

As S.A.G.E. Officers identify these individuals, various intervention and suppression efforts are put into play designed to dissuade that person from the gang lifestyle. S.A.G.E. Officers are committed to this effort and would like the community to know that their support in this endeavor is appreciated. Citizens of Shasta County are encouraged to contact the law enforcement agency in their area with any questions, concerns or information about suspected gang activity.
