On 3/9/2009 at approximately 8:57 pm officers from the Redding Police Department responded to 2556 Wyndham Lane to a report of a disturbance call. Upon arrival officers discovered Anthony Capucine (31 years of age) from McCloud and Rachella McMillan (28 years of age) also from McCloud, had been struck by a vehicle driven by Eden Edwards (20 years of age) from Redding.

The investigation revealed that Edwards got into an argument with Capucine and McMillan, who were visiting her. The argument spilled over into the driveway of the residence. Edwards entered her vehicle and intentionally struck McMillan as she backed out of her driveway. Capucine came to McMillan's assistance and was also intentionally struck by Edwards.

McMillan's injuries were minor while Capucine complained of significant pain to his head and ribs. Both were going to seek medical care at Shasta Regional Medical Center.

Edwards fled the scene but later drove to the Redding Police Department where she contacted police officers to provide a statement. Edwards was subsequently arrested and taken to Shasta County jail where she was booked for assault with a deadly weapon.
