FLOODING

On 03-16-09 at approximately 2:00 p.m., the Redding Police Department and Fire Department responded to numerous reports of flooding in the west Redding area due to heavy rains. One flooding area in particular in the area of Eureka Way just east of Buenaventura flooded due to the fact that a large drain was clogged with debris. The Redding Police Department, City of Redding Street Department and Cal Trans responded to this location. At the time of this press release, the City of Redding Streets Department and Cal Trans were still attempting to unclog the major drain in this area. The west and eastbound lanes of Eureka Way were brought down to one lane. All vehicles traveling in this area should be cautious while driving on Eureka Way near Buenaventura. Any flooded areas on the roadway should be avoided. Pedestrians should avoid drainages or swiftly flowing water.
