## PRESS RELEASE UPDATE

Murder Investigation

On Monday, April 20, 2009, the Redding Police Department initiated an investigation into a suspicious death in the canyon area at the south-west end of Masonic Drive. The victim, Timothy Alcorn, 47 years of Redding was found deceased with signs of trauma to his body. Witness information revealed that Mr. Alcorn resided in this canyon area.

On Tuesday, April 21, 2009, the Shasta County Sheriff's Department Coroner's Office performed an autopsy on Mr. Alcorn. The autopsy revealed Mr. Alcorn died as a result of blunt force trauma to the head.

Redding Police Investigators have been actively pursuing numerous leads and interviewing witnesses on this case. On April 23, 2009, Redding Police Investigators received information that two male juveniles and an adult male, all of Redding, were responsible for Mr. Alcorn's beating death.

Both of the juveniles were interviewed and subsequently arrested for the charge of homicide. Both of these juveniles were booked into the Shasta County Juvenile Hall.

The adult male, identified as Albert Curtis Sanchez, 18 years, is still outstanding. Sanchez is wanted for the homicide of Mr. Alcorn and for a probation violation. Albert Sanchez is described as a Hispanic Male, 5'6", 140 lbs., brown eyes and brown hair. Sanchez's photograph can be accessed on the Redding Police Department web site under Redding Police Department's Most Wanted.
