On Thursday April 23, 2009 Redding Police Officers investigated an assault that occurred on Twin View Blvd earlier in the evening. The victim, Brandon Dennis, 16 years, of Redding, was walking on Twin View Boulevard near the interstate 5 under crossing when he was approached by four subjects. The subjects asked Dennis if he was part of a gang. When Dennis denied any gang affiliation he was assaulted by the subjects. Dennis was transported to Shasta Regional Medical Center by a family member where he was treated for facial fractures.

The suspects are described as follows:

Suspect #1 White or Hispanic male adult, early 20's, 200 pounds (muscular build) with brown hair. He was last seen wearing a blue or grey shirt and dark pants. He had unknown type tattoos on his neck and arms.

Suspect #2 White or Hispanic male adult, early 20's, 200 pounds (muscular build) with brown hair. He was last seen wearing a blue or grey shirt and dark pants. He had unknown type tattoos on his neck and arms.

Suspect #3 White or Hispanic male adult in his late 20's, 6'2, 220 pounds with brown hair. He was wearing a blue shirt and dark pants and also had unknown tattoos on his neck and arms.

Suspect #4 White or Hispanic male adult in his late 20's, 6'2, 220 pounds with brown hair. He was wearing a blue shirt and dark pants. He had unknown tattoos on his neck and arms as well as a beard and mustache.
