On Saturday April 25, 2009 at 1:13 A.M. Redding Police officers responded to Club Ice located at 2613 Bechelli Lane in reference to an assault. Officers found the victim, Adam Michael Martinez, 31 years of Redding, unconscious on the dance floor. Employees at Club Ice detained the suspect outside of the establishment. The suspect was identified as Lennart C. Schauman, 29 years of Redding.

The investigation revealed that Schauman punched Martinez in the head a single time after Martinez approached Schauman's girlfriend. The impact from the punch knocked Martinez to the floor. The assault was captured on surveillance cameras inside the club.

Martinez was transported by ambulance to Mercy Medical Center where he underwent emergency brain surgery. His current condition is not known.

Officers arrested Lennart Schauman on the charge of felony battery. Schauman was booked at the Shasta County Jail with bail set in the amount of \$50,000.
