On Wednesday, May 2, 2009 at 8:43 A.M. Redding Police officers investigated a disturbance on the Shasta College Campus where a student threatened an instructor. The victim, Fred Drollinger, 53 years of Redding reported that he was threatened by Zachary McHargue, 19 years of Redding after a disagreement. Drollinger, who is employed at the college as an automotive instructor, said McHargue was upset over a scheduling issue. McHargue reportedly threatened Drollinger while swinging a small baseball bat he retrieved from his vehicle.

Officers located McHarue's vehicle on campus and seized the bat. Police Officers worked with campus security officers in an attempt to locate McHargue. McHargue ultimately surrendered to officers and was taken into custody without incident.

McHargue was arrested for making terrorist threats, possessing an illegal weapon and an outstanding arrest warrant. He was booked at the Shasta County Jail.
