On May 25, 2009 at 7:30 am, officers from the Redding Police Department were alerted to a structure fire in the 1400 block of Arroyo Manor Drive, in the city of Redding. As officers arrived on scene they received information that a male subject had been seen going into the residence after the fire started.

This male subject was not seen exiting the residence and was a concern of fire personnel as they arrived on scene. As fire personnel began to contain the fire, they also searched the residence for the possible victim. A male subject was located in one of the bedrooms and appeared to have suffered a single gunshot wound to the head. The male subject was transported to Mercy Medical Center and his status is unknown at this time.

It is unknown at this time how the fire started and if the male subject was responsible. No other structures were threatened as a result of this fire. The identification of the male subject is being withheld at this time as the investigation is still ongoing.
