DUI Offender Stakeout Operation


May 28, 2009

The Redding Police Department partnered with the Shasta County Probation Department and conducted a stakeout at the Shasta County Probation Office. The purpose of this operation was to confirm that individuals who reported to the probation office this day whose driver's license were suspended due to convictions for operating a vehicle while under the influence were in fact compiling with their suspension orders and the terms of their probation.

Individuals with a suspended driver's license were followed from the probation office to a vehicle. If these people were observed driving away from the location, a traffic stop was subsequently made on the vehicle. A total of 14 people were followed from the probation office during this operation.

We are happy to report that 10 people on probation were followed from the probation office to vehicles and found to not be driving and in compliance with the terms of their probation orders and their drivers' license suspension orders.

However, today's operation resulted in 4 people arrested for operating a vehicle on a suspended license and 4 vehicles were towed and impounded. Those individuals were Bobby Sisson 38 years of Redding, Roy Rodgers 41 years of Redding, Jared Vleming 25 years of Redding and Daniel O'Keefe 39 years of Redding.
