On June 2nd 2009, at 8:22 PM Redding Police officers responded to the Mt. Shasta Mall on a report of a female being assaulted by a male subject. As the first officers arrived, the male suspect, later identified as Jeremy Stone, 35 years, of Redding, fled on foot southbound through Discovery Village and onto Highway 44.

Officer Kinneavy and his police canine Vermut tracked Stone to Interstate 5 near Palisades Avenue. Stone was found hiding in the bushes next to the freeway. He refused to obey commands from officers to come out from where he was hiding. He was bitten by the police canine before being taken into custody.

Stone is currently on Parole, and has an extensive history of violence and narcotic violations.

The investigation revealed that Stone had assaulted his 23 year old fiancée while they were parked in their vehicle in the south parking lot of the mall. Stone allegedly choked the victim and covered her mouth with his hand to prevent her from calling out for help. The victim's injuries consisted of multiple abrasions on her neck. She did not require immediate medical treatment.

Stone was treated at Shasta Regional Medical Center for injuries sustained during the arrest. He was subsequently booked at the Shasta County Jail on charges of felony domestic violence, false imprisonment, and parole violation.
