On Saturday June 6, 2009 at 1:00 A.M. a resident of the Gold Hills Subdivision reported seeing a vehicle driving on the golf course near his house. Redding Police officers responded to the area and found extensive damage to the approach and putting green on the first hole. Officers checked the area but could not locate the vehicle.

At approximately 7:45 A.M. the same resident contacted the police department after observing a similar vehicle stuck in a ditch on Twin View Blvd. Officers contacted the registered owner of the vehicle, Gerald Dustin Harris, 23 years at his residence in Shasta Lake City. Harris told officers that he and a friend were responsible for the damage at the golf course. He confirmed that he was driving his 2000 Chevy pickup before he got stuck on Twin View Blvd.

Officers arrested Harris for felony vandalism. He was booked at the Shasta County Jail with bail set in the amount of \$10,000. The cost to repair the damage to the golf course is estimated to be between \$3,000 and \$5,000.
