At approximately 1:20 AM on Monday morning, officers from the Redding Police Department responded to Redding Furniture and Mattress, located at 30 Lake Blvd, to investigate a report of a possible vehicle theft in progress. Witnesses had called the police after hearing a vehicle alarm sounding and observing two male subjects entering the vehicle.

While the witness was on the phone with Dispatch, the subjects were able to defeat the ignition system and start the vehicle. The vehicle began traveling through the parking lot, but the driver had difficulty getting the large delivery truck into gear and stalled the engine. Officers arrived on scene and both subjects fled on foot.

Officers apprehended Jacob Greenlee, 25 years, of Portland, Oregon, after a short foot pursuit. The second subject, Richard Traver, 38 years, of Vancouver, Washington, was located a short time later hiding inside the City of Redding fountain located on Market St at Lake Blvd.

Both subjects were booked into Shasta County Jail for Vehicle Theft, Possession of Burglary Tools, and Resisting Arrest.
