On Saturday June 27, 2009 at 12:33 P.M. Redding Police Officers responded to a medical call for service at 1075 Le Brun Lane at the request of the Redding Fire Department. The Fire Department and other emergency medical personnel were providing medical aid to a construction worker who had fallen while working at the site.

The fall victim, Pascual Solorzano, 50 years of Red Bluff, was on a second story scaffolding when he slipped and fell to the ground. Solorzano was working with two other subjects who were hired to remodel the exterior of the apartment building. Solorzano sustained head and neck injuries and was transported by ambulance to Mercy Medical Center. He is currently in critical condition in the intensive care unit at Mercy Medical Center.

Investigations associated with industrial accidents are referred to the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration (Cal/OSHA) for review.
