On Sunday, July 26, 2009 at approximately 12:15 PM, officers from the Redding Police Department responded to the area of Movies 10 on Old Alturas Road, in the City of Redding for the report of a person being struck by a vehicle. Officers found Casey Max Weaver, 32 years, of Redding had been struck by a vehicle driven by his mother.

Myrna Sherrie Weaver, 59 yrs., of Lubbock, Texas had flown to Redding with one of her adult sons to visit with her second adult son of Redding, Casey Max Weaver. The family attended church Sunday morning and had plans to drive to San Francisco afterward. They traveled as far as Home Depot on Churn Creek Road when an argument between the brothers started. The brother from Texas got out of the car to go for a walk and calm down. Myrna Weaver drove to the Movies 10 parking lot when Casey Weaver decided get out of the rental car and go back to assault his brother. Myrna Weaver chased down Casey Weaver with the rental car and ran him over. Casey Weaver suffered scrapes, bruises, torn clothing, and an injured ankle. He refused medical treatment against the advice of medical personnel that responded.

Myrna Weaver was arrested and booked at the Shasta County Jail for assault with a deadly weapon.
