On 8/1/2009, at 9:49 AM, officers of the Redding Police Department responded to 845 Locust Street in regards to a hit and run traffic collision that had just occurred. While officers were responding, they were notified that a male pedestrian, Corrie Lee Campbell, 33 years of Redding, had been run over by a vehicle.

Upon arrival, officers determined that Campbell had been run over by a white Chevy Blazer with a Missouri plate and driven by his girlfriend, who has not been positively identified at this time. Officers at the scene also determined that Campbell had been in a verbal argument with the female driver prior to being hit by the vehicle.

The female suspect also fled the scene in the white Chevy Blazer prior to the officer's arrival. It was later determined that the white Chevy Blazer with Missouri plates was in fact stolen.

Investigating officers later recovered this stolen vehicle at the Redwood Mobile Home Park in Redding, California. The female suspect is still outstanding. The female suspect's description is a white female adult in her twenties, with blonde hair, approximately 5'2".

The victim, Corrie Campbell, was transported to Mercy Hospital with minor injuries.
