On Friday, August 7, 2009 at 12:33 am, a citizen called the Redding Police Department to report hearing broken glass coming from an unknown business in the 2000 block of California Street. Officers responded to the area and located a broken glass front door to the business "215 Patient Resource" at 2035 California Street. The business had a marijuana plant growing in the window and it appeared the suspect was trying to break the glass door in an attempt to steal the marijuana plant.

When officers arrived, two males ran from the scene. Officers pursued the two males and apprehended both. The suspects were both juveniles.

During the foot chase, one of the juveniles attempted to climb a wrought iron fence. After losing his grip of the fence, the juvenile slipped and lacerated his right forearm on the fence. The juvenile was treated at Shasta Regional Medical Center and received multiple sutures to his forearm. He was later booked at Shasta County Juvenile Hall for attempted burglary, resisting an officer, and an arrest warrant from a previous offense.

The second juvenile was booked at Shasta County Juvenile Hall for attempted burglary and did not resist officers.
