On Saturday, August 15, 2009 at 7:50 A.M. the Redding Police Department received multiple reports of a traffic collision on Pine Street north of Placer Street. Officers responded to the scene and found a Dodge Caravan had collided with a parked AT & T line truck. The Redding Fire Department assisted other emergency medical services personnel with the extraction of the solo driver from the vehicle.

The female driver was northbound on Pine Street when she collided with the parked line truck. The driver is not being identified based on the seriousness of her injuries. She was transported to Mercy Medical Center and a trauma alert was declared by medical personnel. The cause of the collision is under investigation. Officers have not determined whether the driver was wearing a seatbelt at the time of the collision. Officers closed two lanes on Pine Street between Placer and Yuba Street for approximately two hours, but all lanes have since reopened.
