On Tuesday, August 25, 2009 at 1:32 P.M. Officers from the Redding Police Department responded to an apartment building in the forty six hundred block of Westside Road after receiving multiple reports that citizens were detaining a subject who had exposed himself to a three year old girl. Officers found the subject locked inside his vehicle, surrounded by approximately ten subjects who reside at the apartment building. The subject, who was later identified as Donald Dale Zamora, 58 years of Redding, was detained without incident.

The investigation revealed that Zamora approached a three year old girl and her fifteen year old brother in a common area inside the apartment building. Zamora's pants were unzipped and his genitals were exposed. Zamora threatened the fifteen year old juvenile. Several minutes later, Zamora grabbed the three year old girl by the arm in a parking lot. He pulled the victim toward his Chevy pickup. The victim's fifteen year old brother intervened by pushing the suspect and was able to free his sister.

Officers arrested Zamora on the charges of indecent exposure, kidnapping and assault with the intent to commit a sexual assault. He was booked at the Shasta County Jail with bail set in the amount of \$500,000. A records check revealed that Zamora was arrested on August 20, 2009 by the Redding Police Department for indecent exposure.
