The Shasta County Avoid the SIX, consisting of the Redding Police Department, Shasta County Probation Department, Shasta County Sheriff's Office, Anderson Police Department, Shasta County Marshal's Office and the California Highway Patrol, conducted a DUI and driver license checkpoint between 1800 and 2300 hours on Friday in the City of Shasta Lake.

A total of 610 vehicles passed through the checkpoint and 35 were screened by officers. Seven field sobriety tests were administered and Two individuals were arrested for DUI.

In addition, one individual was arrested on outstanding warrants. Three citations were issued to include: two for being unlicensed drivers, and one for driving on suspended driver's licenses. One vehicle was towed.
