On Tuesday, September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009, at 11:56 PM Redding Police officers responded to a traffic collision involving a vehicle into a residence at the intersection of Mission De Oro Drive and Tanglewood Drive.

Officers determined that Nelson T. Sebra Jr., 35 years, of Sacramento, was driving his 2005 Audi sedan northbound on Mission De Oro Drive when he failed to stop for the stop sign at the intersection of Tanglewood Drive. The vehicle continued across the north side of the intersection onto the sidewalk, drove through a six foot stucco wall and into the garage at 696 Buckthorn Drive. Sebra's vehicle continued through the stucco exterior wall of the garage, and collided with the homeowner's 2002 Honda Civic parked inside.

Marilyn Clark, 70 years, was sleeping inside her residence at the time of the collision. She was not injured. The collision caused major damage to her residence and her vehicle parked inside the garage.

Nelson T. Sebra Jr. did not suffer any injuries as a result of the traffic collision. He was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol and booked into the Shasta County Jail.
