At approximately 1:00 PM today, Officer Peterson of the Redding Police Department observed a stolen car traveling on Westside Road near Buenaventura Boulevard. When Officer Peterson turned around to follow the vehicle, the two occupants had already parked the car and fled.

With the aide of a police canine, the California Highway Patrol helicopter, and several citizens pointing out the direction that the driver of the stolen car was running, he was ultimately located at the Shasta County Social Services building on Brestauer Lane.

Nocona Redwolf Wilson, 19 years of Redding, was arrested for being in possession of a stolen vehicle and for fleeing from police. This is Wilson's third arrest this summer for being in possession of stolen cars. Wilson was arrested on June 19th, and again on August 22nd for being in possession of stolen vehicles.

The Redding Police would like to remind people to always lock their vehicles, never leave their vehicles running while unattended, remove the keys when leaving the vehicle, and never leave valuable property inside of it which can be stolen.

The Redding Police always appreciate the help of concerned citizens assisting in the apprehension of criminal suspects.
