FIGHT/VANDALISM

Case #09-63310

On Tuesday, September 22, at 1:39 a.m., Redding police officers responded to the Shasta Villa apartments at 275 Hilltop Drive, regarding reports of a fight involving a group of eight or more people. The fight took place in the street and the adjacent parking lot. Some of the residents heard what sounded like gunshots.

Upon their arrival, officers observed one subject running from the location, jumping fences in the apartment complex. The subject, a 17-year old male, was apprehended. Officers found him in possession of Vicodin. He was arrested for resisting an officer and possession of a controlled substance. The other people involved had already fled in a car.

Residents and officers found three cars in the Shasta Villa parking lot whose windows had been broken out by one of the people involved in the fight. The owners of the cars were not connected to the people involved in the fight. Officers found a crowbar which apparently had been used during the fight and to break the cars' windows. Officers did not find any evidence of gunfire.
