On January 5, 2010, at approximately 3:50p.m., officers of the Redding Police Department were dispatched to the report of a collision involving a vehicle and two children who were riding bicycles near the intersection of Edgewater Drive and Nighthawk Lane. The investigation revealed that a 1996 Acura driven by Renee M. Alvarez 34 years of Redding was traveling north west on Edgewater Drive. An 11 year old female and 10 year old male, both of Redding, were riding bicycles entered the intersection without yielding from westbound Nighthawk Lane. Alvarez could not avoid the female who was struck by the vehicle and subsequently fell to the ground sustaining minor injuries. The 10 year old male was not struck and was uninjured. Neither juvenile was wearing their helmet at the time of this collision as required by law.

The children entered the intersection without yielding and caused this collision.
