Fugitive Arrest

On January 7, 2010, Investigators from the Redding Police Department received information from the Federal Bureau of Investigations regarding a wanted fugitive living within the City of Redding. The FBI stated Daniel Warren Neill, 35 years, was wanted for a felony warrant out of Hillsborough County Sheriff's Department in Tampa, Florida. The charges on the warrant were aggravated assault with a weapon against a law enforcement officer, battery and resisting arrest.

Investigators immediately began searching for the fugitive with the assistance of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation Special Service Unit as well as Redding Police Department Field Operations Officers.

Investigators were able to determine that Neill was playing golf at a local Redding golf course. Redding Police personnel and SSU Special Agents located Neill leaving the golf course and placed him under arrest for the outstanding warrant. Neill was subsequently booked at Shasta County Jail for the listed warrant.
