On January 19, 2010 at 1:59 p.m., Officer Cogle of the Redding Police Department while on normal patrol recognized a parolee at large by the name of Jonathan Paul Bryan, 25 years of age, in the area of 1670 Hartnell Avenue (Towermart).

Officer Cogle attempted to make contact with the wanted parolee and Bryan fled the scene on foot. Parolee Bryan has an extensive history of violence and was considered armed and dangerous. Bryan had been absconding from parole officers since October of 2009.

Bryan fled to a nearby neighborhood and assisting officers converged in the area to search for him. Officer Rhoads used his K-9 (Car) to search for the parolee. Parolee Bryan was found hiding underneath a tarp in the back yard of a residence in the 2800 block of Fairway Avenue. Parolee Bryan was apprehended by the K-9 and assisting officers.

Bryan was later booked into Shasta County Jail for resisting arrest and a parole violation.
