On March 21, 2010, at 6:24 P.M., Officers from the Redding Police Department responded to the 40 Lake Blvd. (Dollar Tree Store) in regards to an attempt kidnapping that had just occurred outside the listed business. Upon arrival, officers were able to determine that the ten year old female victim was contacted by the suspect outside near the entrance of the business.

The suspect was described as a male Hispanic adult, twenty five to thirty years old, shoulder length brown hair, brown eyes, thin build, no facial hair, wearing a white T-shirt with the word (Element) written on the front, and a black ball cap with a white letter "A" on it.

After the suspect contacted the victim, he grabbed her arm and pulled her to the west end of the business complex. The victim struggled with the suspect and was able to get free of the suspect. The victim then was able to summons her mother who was exiting the store.

A California Highway Patrol Air Unit and Redding Police Department K-9 Unit assisted in the search for the suspect. The suspect was last seen running in the parking lot of the nearby ShopKo Store. Officers at this time are checking security surveillance recordings from businesses near the scene of the crime.
