On Thursday, March 25, 2010 Officers from the Redding Police Department conducted minor decoy compliance checks at fifteen Redding area businesses. In this type of operation, a minor decoy under the direct supervision of the officer, attempted to purchase an alcoholic beverage from the licensed establishments.

The minor decoy purchased an alcoholic beverage at four of the businesses. The cases will be submitted to the Shasta County District Attorney's Office for prosecution as well as the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for administrative review.
