On April 13, 2010 at approximately 8:00 am, the Redding Police Department was called to a report of an acid bomb at a residence in the 3800 block of Alta Mesa drive. When officer's arrived on scene they determined there was a suspected explosive device at the location. Notifications were made to surrounding residences through the use of the reverse 911 system notifying them of the hazard. A partial road closure was also initiated. The precautionary measures were to provide safety to the neighbors, pedestrians and passing motorists.

The Shasta County Bomb Squad was called and the device was rendered safe. The device was a plastic bottle containing chemically reactive substances.

Possession of this type of destructive device is considered a felony offense in the State of California.
