In an effort to improve the safety of our local roadways, the Redding Police Department is partnering with the California Highway Patrol to begin working joint enforcement details aimed at improving traffic safety. The location of the details will include various locations in the Redding area, such as Highway 44, Downtown Redding and the Cypress at Interstate 5 interchange. "I look forward to these joint operations", said Jerry Flavin, Captain of the Redding Area CHP Office. "In these days of tight fiscal constraints working together only provides a higher level of service to the public and serves to strengthen our relationships with allied agencies."

Redding Police Lieutenant Eric Wallace joined Captain Flavin by stating, "Local law enforcement working in a collaborative effort, benefits the public by making our streets safer. It is the goal of both agencies to educate the public regarding traffic safety tips and provide focused traffic enforcement in target locations." The focus of these joint operations will be in areas of high traffic volume which have a disproportionate number of collisions or violations.
