Today at approximately 11:15 a.m., the Redding Police Department was notified of a shooting victim in the roadway at Cypress Avenue and Alfreda Way. Upon arrival, officers located Janet L. Funderburk, 20 years old of Redding, lying in the roadway suffering from a gunshot wound to her lower back.

Upon initial investigation, it appears as though Ms. Funderburk was driving a black Cadillac Escalade registered to her and her father. She had at least five other individuals as passengers in the vehicle with her. Apparently, an unknown caliber gun was discharged within the vehicle and the bullet struck Ms. Funderburk in the back. The vehicle continued forward before coming to a stop at the east side of the intersection. Ms. Funderburk exited the vehicle and fell to the pavement.

At least three of the passengers were detained and transported to RPD Investigations for interviews. These interviews are continuing at this time. At least one individual fled the location and is being sought for questioning. The weapon has not been located. One of the individuals being questioned is an admitted gang member.

The victim was transported to Mercy Hospital and is in surgery. Her injuries are severe but at this time do not appear to be life threatening.
