On June 12, 2010 at approximately 2115 Hours Johnathon Dean Hogue 19 years old of Shasta Lake City came to the Redding Police Department to turn himself in for the robbery reported June 10, 2010 that occurred outside the Lake Liquor Market at 1345 Lake Blvd. The Redding Police Department developed leads and information indicating Hogue as the suspect. Hogue stated due to the efforts of the Redding Police Department to capture him, including the news media broadcasts, as well as the seriousness of the case he decided turning himself in was in his best interest.

Hogue voluntarily provided a full statement at the police department and submitted to arrest for the robbery without incident. During the interview Hogue said the robbery was committed due to a drug deal for OxyContin going bad. He admitted to stealing both money and OxyContin from the victim. He was subsequently booked into Shasta County Jail for Robbery, Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and Conspiracy to commit a felony. On the same date at approximately 2230 hours a second person came forward with information regarding the case which corroborated the statement provided by Hogue.

The Investigation of this matter is on going.
