On Tuesday, June 29, 2010 at 3:12 pm, Redding Police officers responded to a robbery at the Bigfoot Recycling, 210 Lake Blvd. An employee called Shascom, advising the suspect brandished a knife and demanded money. The suspect then fled the area in a tan Honda Accord with an undisclosed amount of cash.

Prior to officers arriving at the scene, Shascom received 911 calls that a tan Honda Accord had been involved in a traffic collision at 2370 Twin View Blvd. Citizens reported the driver of the vehicle had fled the traffic collision on foot. The suspect then attempted to take an occupied vehicle on Oasis Court, but was not successful. The suspect fled into the wooded area northeast of Oasis Road and Twin View Blvd.

Officers from the Redding Police Department, Shasta County Sheriff's Office, and the California Highway Patrol (CHP) searched for the suspect. A police canine and the CHP helicopter were also used for the search. The suspect was not located.

Further investigation revealed the tan Honda Accord had been stolen from South Redding on June 26, 2010. The vehicle was impounded for evidence processing.

The suspect was described as a white male, 25 years old, 6' tall, with red hair. He was wearing fatigue pants and a dark shirt. He was described as having multiple tattoos on his upper body.
