UPDATED INFORMATION Assault with a Deadly Weapon

On July 22, 2010, at 2:46 pm, Redding Police officers responded to the Holiday Market located at 3315 Placer Street in regard to a man wielding a weapon and threatening customers.

An employee of the store, Aaron Weigel, reported he had contacted the suspect near the dumpsters at the rear of the store. Mr. Weigel told the suspect he was trespassing and needed to leave the premises. The man agreed to leave but stated he would return to the store to kill Mr. Weigel.

The suspect returned to the store a short time later carrying an axe. He entered the store through the north door, walked through the store, and exited the south doors. Mr. Weigel contacted the man at the front of the store, at which time, the suspect attempted to strike Mr. Weigel with the axe, threatening to kill him. The suspect then fled from the store toward a wooded area south of Placer Street

Officers established a perimeter and used a police canine to search the area. After an extended search, the suspect was not located. Officers developed information regarding the identity of the suspect, and established the suspect's identity as **EDWARD ARLIN FOURZON**, age 55, of Redding. The suspect, FOURZON, was last seen wearing a dark tee-shirt, black shorts, and black shoes.

The Redding Police Department is still on the lookout for this suspect.
