On July 25, 2010 at 11:19 P.M. officers of the Redding Police Department were dispatched to a collision involving a vehicle and a bicyclist. The bicyclist had been traveling eastbound along the south curb line of Hartnell Avenue west of the intersection with Lawrence Road. The bicyclist suddenly swerved into the number two eastbound traffic lane of Hartnell crossing into the path of a 1999 red Pontiac convertible.

The Pontiac was driven by Adam Muncy 18 years of Redding. Muncy was unable to avoid the bicyclist. The bicyclist was struck and thrown to the roadway. The collision was witnessed by a citizen who was traveling approximately 200 feet to the rear to the rear of Muncy's vehicle who saw the bicyclist swerve into the path of Muncy.

At this time the identity of the bicyclist is not known. The bicyclist was described a white male approximately 40-45 years of age. The bicyclist was not wearing a helmet. The bicyclist was transported to Mercy Hospital for further care and evaluation.
