Driving Under the Influence/ Driver License Checkpoint

July 28, 2010

The Redding Police Department conducted a DUI and driver license checkpoint on Churn Creek Road on Wednesday, July 28, 2010. A total of 687 vehicles passed through the checkpoint and were screened by officers. 17 drivers were stopped for further investigation, either at the checkpoint or by officers patrolling near the checkpoint. 3 drivers were given field sobriety tests. One driver was arrested for driving under the influence. 6 drivers were found to be driving on a suspended license and cited. 6 vehicles were towed, including those of the suspended drivers.

Two representatives of the Shasta County chapter of "Mothers Against Drunk Driving" (M.A.D.D.) were present to hand out information to motorists.
