On Friday, August 13, 2010 Officers from the Redding Police Department conducted minor decoy compliance checks at twenty Redding area businesses. In this type of operation, a minor decoy under the direct supervision of the officers, attempts to purchase an alcoholic beverage from licensed establishments.

The minor decoy purchased an alcoholic beverage at one of the businesses (Kent's Meats). The case will be submitted to the Shasta County District Attorney's Office for prosecution as well as the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for administration review. Officers cited the following subject for selling alcoholic to a minor.

Rhonda R. Ducoing, 43 years of Anderson at the Kent's Meats at 8080 Airport Road.

The nineteen businesses that did not sell to the minor decoy were Beacon Gas (8510 Airport Road), Shell Station (9539 Old Forty Four), Valero Station (5150 Churn Creek Rd.), Texaco Food Mart (5001 S. Bonnyview Rd.), Chevron Food Mart (4746 Churn Creek Rd.), Winn River Mini Mart (2415 S. Bonnyview Rd.), Clear Creek Market, Rite Aid (Westwood Village), Holiday Market (Westwood Village), AM/PM Mini Mart (Highway 273), Gas 4 Less (Pine St./Tehama St.), Shell Station (1801 Park Marina), USA Gas (1233 Hilltop Drive), B&B Liquor, Shell Station (510 E. Cypress Ave.), Liquor King, USA Gas (Churn Creek/Hartnell), Circle K (1015 Hartnell Ave.), and Bob's Liquor.
