HUNTING PROHIBITED WITHIN THE REDDING CITY LIMITS Aug. 31, 2010

The Redding Police Department would like to remind the public that the Redding Municipal Code prohibits the discharging of any type of firearm within the Redding City limits (RMC 10.58.010).

The Sacramento River Waterway contains several islands within the City limits that are popular with hunters. The Redding City limits encompass the entire waterway from the holding ponds south of the Clear Creek Treatment plant to just south of Keswick Dam. Due to the prohibition of shooting within the City limits, hunting is illegal on these islands and the entire waterway within the City. Violation of this section is a Misdemeanor.

Dove season opens tomorrow, Sept. 1, 2010, and hunters will be contacted and subject to citation for any violations of the shooting ordinance.
